



# Saxon Sports 20/20

## Information & Rules

### 1 Playing Dates

The competition for this season will be played on a Tuesday evening. All matches will commence at 5:30pm.

Pool Rounds:

- 1- November 13th 2018
- 2- November 20<sup>th</sup> 2018
- 3- November 27<sup>th</sup> 2018

**Semi Finals:** Tuesday December 4<sup>th</sup> 2018  
**Grand Final:** Tuesday December 11<sup>th</sup> 2018

### 2 Rescheduling Matches

It is preferred that all matches are played on the Tuesday evening, however, if conditions dictate that a match cannot be commenced and completed on the same day, the 20/20 coordinators may approve a rescheduling of the match to be played on another day, as long as the following conditions are met:

- Both clubs are in agreement at the suggested playing date
- Umpire/s have confirmed availability to attend
- The match is completed within 7 days from the date of the original scheduled game (see Rule 42 – Delayed or Interrupted Matches).
- There is no ground clash with other matches on the RDCA fixture
- Home club has council approval to use ground on rescheduled date.

### 3 Clothing

All players must be in their clubs Coloured Short Form Uniform including pants. Pads must also be Coloured or have Coloured Cladding.

### 4 Reporting scores

Both teams should enter their full score details into My Cricket as per the normal home and away process, as soon as possible after the game.



## **5 Umpires**

One umpire will be provided for each match during the qualifying rounds and quarter finals. Teams will need to provide a square leg umpire for the match.

## **6 Umpires Fees**

All umpire fees are included in the sponsorship by Saxon Sports, however, the umpires are to be paid by the clubs at the time of the game, \$60.00 per team, and 40% of the fees paid will be credited back to the club as a reimbursement by the RDCA.

## **7 Match Balls**

A white match ball will be provided for each game and clubs need to collect two from Saxon Sports in Croydon which is part of their sponsorship.

It is the responsibility of the home club to have spare white balls as a backup in case the match ball is damaged or lost. White balls are available through Saxon Sports.

## **8 Boundaries & Line Marking**

The line around the wicket is 30 metres. This should be marked by producing two semi-circles from the centre stump at each end and a parallel line between them.

Boundaries should be marked at 50 metres.

**There is no longer a 10 metre bowling restriction so this doesn't need to be marked.**

## **9 Guest Players and Eligibility**

Clubs are no longer permitted a guest player. All players must be registered members of that club.

Any player who has played senior cricket at any other club (including district, sub district and other competitions) this current season will be deemed ineligible without written permission from the T20 coordinator.

## **10 Qualification**

This season the qualification for the T20 finals will require all competitors to have participated in a minimum of 3 matches for that club in any format prior to that final. Eligible matches include T20, Juniors, Seniors & Vets.

## **11 Rules**

The Rules are in the RDCA Rules book (# 39 – 51) which is available online and has been distributed to your club secretary. The major change to playing conditions for this season is the removal of the restricted run up for bowlers.
