

The original Minutes of the Lilydale and District Cricket Association Annual Meeting for season 1929-30 have not been found but there was a newspaper article in the Healesville and Yarra Glen Guardian Saturday 27th September 1930 that provides some details.

#### **"Lilydale and District Cricket Association**

Keeness was shown at the annual meeting of the Lilydale and District Association when, besides delegates from all last year's clubs, ambassadors from Mount Evelyn were present.

The balance sheet covering last year's activities was submitted by Mr. C. Burrows and reflected a very healthy position, the sum of five pounds three shillings and one penny (?) standing to the credit of the association.

Officers elected for the ensuing year are – President, Mr. T. Jobling; vice-presidents, Mr. N.W. Gill (Lilydale), Cr. F. W. Britton (Seville), Messrs. J. Low (Mt. Evelyn), F.W. Vear (Healesville), G. Lorimer (Woori Yallock); Hon. Secretary and treasurer Mr. C. Burrows (acting for three months).

The Mount Evelyn Cricket Club was cordially accepted as a participating eleven in the association.

It was decided to commence the competition on October 4.

Owing to unforeseen circumstances arising it was reluctantly decided that the annual match with the Ringwood Association would have to be abandoned this year.

The association will again enter an eleven for the Country Cricket Week.
