The balance sheet showed that the association had a balance of five shillings and six pence to its credit. In the absence of the President (Mr. C. Hand) the Chair was occupied by Mr. R. Goode. The chairman welcomed the two new clubs and trusted that we would have a successful season's cricket.

The association this season has decided semi-finals and finals shall be played to decide the premier club.

A trophy to the value of five pounds and five shillings (five guineas) will be competed for. Mr. C. Hand kindly donated two pounds to the association.

The officers this year are – President, Mr. C. Hand, auditor – Mr. J.G. Leckie, Hon. Secretary and Treasurer A. Jones. The fixtures are now in the hands of the printer and will be published shortly.
