Rule. Rule 8: Matches commence on Oct. 3. 1936.

Amendments. Rule 12: In the event of a team withdrawing from the Competition during the Season, the forfeited matches shall be regarded as a Bye & be awarded three points.

Rule 13: Clauses 2 & 3. deleted & the following rule inserted: "All players must register with their respective clubs, each season, before playing. Such registrations, to be accompanied with a registration fee of 6<sup>s</sup>, & to be lodged with the Association Secretary by the Friday before each match & published in the following issue of the local paper."

Rule 14: Add the Shire of Trukham & Blackburn. Insert between words: "Spungvale Rd. to Wellington 1/2. Spungvale Station. along Rail Road to Brandon Robinson St. to Pinnis Highway to Clow St. to Black to Wellington Rd."

Rule 16: Delete words "after that date - - - - to the Local Rules" & insert - "After that date a player may not transfer to a lower grade, unless a majority of the matches played in, during the season, to date of such transfer by such player shall have been in the lower grade."

Rule 24: Delete words after "later than" - & insert "5<sup>15</sup> pm."

Resolved to forward letter of appreciation to Mr. Donaldson.

Rule amendments: 21. Finals. The two leading clubs shall compete

in a final round of matches, which must be played to a finish, etc. etc. carried.

Rule 22. **Protests.** Addition: Any penalty incurred by a club through protest lodged during the final round shall apply only to the match on which the protest is lodged.  
A. Club playing a player contrary to these rules may lose the match or matches in which such player took part. carried.

Rule 25. deleted.

Rule 11. **Executive.** Addition: The Executive shall have complete control of Umpires - Professional & Amateurs, & shall allot the appointments for the season. carried.

**Adoption of Rules** Rules as amended were adopted.

**Professional Umpires** Resolved that in A. Grade, Professional Umpires be appointed for the season, at a flat rate of 7/6 per Saturday. That an advt. be placed in the local paper, calling for applications & that the applications be dealt with by Executive.

**Payment.** Resolved that the clubs engaged be responsible for the payment of Umpires. & if Umpire, appointed for a match report for duty at the ground, that they are entitled to their fee, if no play takes place. The competing teams to pay Umpires at the close of each day's play.

**Uniform Ball.** A motion to adopt a uniform ball was defeated.

Resolved to recommend to clubs the use of the balls as listed by Mr. Donahoe, & that every support be given to Mr. Donahoe.
