

## Lilydale Cricket Association

### ANNUAL MEETING.

Delegates from all clubs in the Lilydale District Association attended the annual meeting at the Melba Park clubrooms on Tuesday evening. Mr. N. W. Gill (president) occupied the chair.

Prospects for the forthcoming season are particularly bright. Players are eager to start practice, and it is confidently expected that the finalists of the past two years will not have things their own way in future contests, as every club is hopeful of fielding improved sides.

It was decided to conduct A. and B. grade competitions. Seven teams have entered the former section, and six the latter. The competition will start on the first Saturday in October, when the following teams will be engaged:—

A. Grade.—Yarra Junction v. Healesville, Lilydale v. Seville, Wandin v. Mt. Evelyn, Woori Yallock a bye.

B. Grade.—Wandin East v. Lilydale, Mt. Evelyn v. Woom Yallock, Seville v. Wandin.

In order to complete the season before football matches are resumed, it was decided to cancel two matches in the second round. This will enable the finals to be played early in April.

A suggestion by the Wandin delegates that something special in the way of a trophy be awarded the Centenary premiers was approved. The secretary was instructed to make enquiries concerning the cost of procuring a shield, a cup, or some other suitable memento, and report to a future meeting.
