UMPIRES COMMITTEE

This Committee continued to function successfully during the 1958/59 season. A few new members were welcomed but unfortunately some older ones were lost, leaving the net position as far as numbers were concerned very much the same as in the previous season. It is to be hoped that all members of the Association will do their utmost to increase the membership of this most During the season many complaints were voiced (including one official protest) over incidents which could not have occurred if official umpires had been To alleviate the position only one umpire was allotted to "B" Grade matches, in lieu of the usual two. This allowed twice the number of "B" Grade matches to be umpired officially, but the only really satisfactory solution is for the Umpires Committee to be numerically strong enough to provide umpires at all matches under the control of this Association.

INTER ASSOCIATION MATCHES

On Australia Day 26th January, 1959 we played 3 inter-Association mx matches namely:-

The R.D.C.A. were unsuccessful in the senior matches, losing the match against the Northern Suburban District by only one run. The Juniors however held up our prestige with a comfortable win.

JUNIOR COACHING SCHEME

During 1958/59 the Junior Coaching scheme sponsored by the Victorian Cricket Association was commenced with Richmond and Camberwell clubs having the responsibility of cur districts. Cordial relationships were established with these clubs who each toured our grounds during separate Saturday mornings. A subsequent film evening sponsored by the Richmond Club received very poor report from our juniors and was a disappointment to your Executive who organised the function. At time of writing this report, discussions are taking place between the V.C.A., District and Sub-District Clubs and Junior Associations in an endeavour to assist the coaching scheme and it is hoped that Clubs within the R.D.C.A. will take the opportunity afforded to the juniors by this Scheme.
