PRESIDENTS REPORT

Having assumed the role of President, after only one year on the committee, I have been on a continual learning curve. The following comments reflect my observations of the season, but in general I was happy with the way things went.

Whilst the season progressed relatively smoothly, it was not without incident. All associated at junior level must work together to ensure that matches are played in the right spirit and within the code of conduct laws.

At last years "Rules meeting" two significant changes were approved for implementation in season 1995/96. An Under 10 non-competitive grade was created and this, no doubt, played a large part in the big jump in new registrations. Our new player numbers exceeded 700 which represents an increase of 25% over the previous season.

The introduction of "Proof of Age" for new registrations had its teething problems, with the additional paperwork a burden for junior co-ordinators and particularly, our Registration Secretary. I'm sure this aspect will be reviewed and refined by the incoming committee.

Although clubs were given an amnesty period to get all in order, it was disappointing that some did not give it the attention necessary resulting in loss of points and/or fines. Junior Co-ordinators, please be extremely conscious of your responsibilities in this area as it could be detrimental to a teams chance of playing in the finals.

Over recent years the number of junior teams fielded by some clubs has fallen away alarmingly. In certain instances that continued in 95/96 and if the clubs concerned do not work extremely hard to reverse the decline it could have serious repercussions in the not too distant future.

The primary source of players for senior teams must be the flow-on from the junior ranks and failure to address this area will make life difficult. It has been stated before, but clubs who do not maximise the use of grounds, by fielding junior teams, run the risk of having councils review their access to the relative facility(ies).

To counter balance the previous comment, it was most pleasing to see quite a number of clubs address the issue at the base level through an Under 10 team or by involvement in the Vic-Hit program. The latter is a Victorian Cricket Association concept designed to expose very young children to the game and teach them the basic fundamentals and rules before they progress to Under 10's or 12's.

Any club that has a genuine desire to establish/maintain depth in its junior teams would be wise to investigate this initiative.

Another pleasing aspect was a new team in Aquinas joining the association. We hope this team was the forerunner to more in the future.

Prior to the commencement of the past two seasons, the committee has arranged Level 1 Coaching Accreditation courses and more than sixty people have attained this qualification. This is an area that we see as of the utmost importance to the development of young cricketers and we plan to place more and more emphasis on this aspect in the years to come.

The junior competition is funded by the clubs through the senior committee but we are very fortunate to have continuing sponsorship from the Veterans Association which this season provided caps (100) for boys in representative teams. Our thanks also to Paul Attfield from Topline Sports who arranged the caps, donated encouragement awards and organised the guest speaker (Ray Bright) for Presentation Night.

This years Presentation Night was held for the first time at Yarra Valley Grammar School, an excellent venue which easily accommodated the large crowd, and we thank the special guests who assisted with presentation of trophies.

Our finals series provided very competitive games with narrow margins in a number of contests. Congratulations to the team members and clubs who won premierships and the individuals who excelled throughout the season.

The RDCA prides itself on being a strong junior competition, and our representative teams, particularly the Under 16's who were undefeated, again did us proud. Congratulations to the players, team managers and all others who assisted in some capacity.

My final vote of thanks goes to fellow committeemen who have provided me with terrific support throughout the season. Until you have been on the committee, it is difficult to fully appreciate the amount of work these people do and we are most fortunate to have capable people willing to take on these positions.

We all have a common goal in providing junior cricketers with the best environment, conditions and facilities in which to develop their prowess and I hope that we can continue to work together to foster the game in our association.

I look forward to seeing you in the coming season.
