While most clubs have recuited well, others have had limited success, and this prompts me to urge all Junior Administrators to review your reciument plans for 1994-95 so that we can attract many new players to cricket.

I am grateful for the assistance and advice which I have received from every member of the Junior Committee, all of whom have carried out their responsibilities to a very high standard. On behalf of the Committee I sincerely thank the Junior Administrators and parents of junior players for their cooperation throughout the season. My thanks goes to the Senior Committee who have supported us so well.
