We were extremely excited to be the only Community Cricket Association in Victoria to be awarded the right by Cricket Victoria to launch our own Women's Competition - RDCA Women's East.

The season sees us now firmly as the home of Women's community Cricket in the East. An exciting season was played over several grades with message clear to all that Women's cricket is alive and well in the RDCA. We are determined in season 22/23 coming to go to another level again with more teams being entered and an even stronger competition.

The RDCA is 100% committed to ensuring that our women's competition has its own clear identity moving forward both on and off the field and that the games, product and direction is driven by the clubs and ladies who play it. We now have a genuine local pathway from blasters right through to seniors.

The YVCA / RDCA merger is now past its second year. The senior committee lead by Pat and Stuart continue to review and assess gradings to ensure all clubs and their teams play in competitive grades. That conversation is an ongoing work in progress but with big strides made this year and further evolution through learning in 22/23 the future looks strong.

Our Juniors continue to hold strong. Overall holding firm from last season with 250 teams across 28 divisions. With a particular highlight being our girl's competition growing from 31 -34 teams. An exceptional achievement amid a second year of lockdown and Covid considerations.

The RDCA Veterans comp whilst not playing the Vets T20 Big Bash due to covid considerations successfully delivered it's Sunday competition. We look forward to the return of the Vets T20 big bash next season.

Lastly congratulations to all award and premierships recipients with particular acknowledgement to our latest Hall of Fame and Legend Status Inductees – Well done !

Looking forward into season 22/23

The RDCA has seen significant growth over the last two seasons through the merger of the YVCA and the launch of the RDCA Women's East competition this growth was no accident and part of a well-executed plan to ensure we as an association even in Covid times grew and flourished.

With that in hand and with a potential return to the 2-day format after 2 seasons of one day games being on the cards,

The coming season will see the focus for the BOM on now consolidating and further securing these achievements and thus further strengthening our position as the Premier Hard wicket competition in Victoria.

Actions steps for this began several months ago. We in the process of a full-scale review and update of the associations 5-year strategic plan which is not limited to but will incorporate aspects such as the following.

- Factoring in two years of significant new growth
- Further consolidation of the YVCA clubs
- Consolidation and growth of our Women's Competition
- Further development of the girls and women's competition and local pathways
- Full scale administration review and update to ensure we are operating in 22/23 with best practise administration, process and procedures.
- The intention for the RDCA to hire a professional administration manager to support both the Junior and senior competitions to professionalise this part of our association due to the RDCA's size and scope.
- Ensure and support continued growth, alignment, and progression of all RDCA committees.
- To ensure that across all our committees and structures we offer the very best club facing service we can to support all of clubs and their continued success.
- To engage via deliberate intent into a continuous improvement process where through feedback that was received through surveys conducted, we now have benchmarks in place we can assess and measure ourselves as an association on.
- To ensure the RDCA remains the premier hard wicket competition in Victoria.
- To review, evaluate, refine, and implement all the key learnings from the last two Covid Years to future proof where possible our competition.

Much has been done over the last two years, however as we now enter a period of consolidation to secure what we have achieved in that time there is also still much to do, the focus shifts and the job is not yet finished.

We must again, across all aspects of the Association, continue to look forward not back and do whatever we can and in some cases whatever we must to ensure and safeguard the progression of the RDCA into the future.

I am very pleased to report that apart from the occasional growing pain and sporadic hiccup the RDCA, your RDCA, has continued to flourish and is in very good shape.

Thank-you for your continued support, I value greatly the relationships I have with all clubs and their players , club members and officials.

## Finance Manager - Graeme Seymour

As we are all aware, season 2021/22 commenced again with COVID protocols hanging over us, but as in the previous year we managed to scrape through relatively unscathed.

On the financial front, the RDCA completed another successful season with Gross Turnover increasing from \$405,386 in 2021 season to \$437,695 in 2022. Some of the major increases being Club Affiliation fees \$61,936 (2021 \$56,718) attributable largely to the new Women's East Competition now being administered by the RDCA. Sponsorship Income increased to \$61,959 (2021 \$42,578) mainly due to a significant increase in our sponsorship arrangement with our major sponsor, Kookaburra Sports. Ball sales increased to \$165,816 (2021 \$153,043) & with the return of an "in person" Senior Presentation Night an additional \$11,873 (2021 \$0) was received.

Our expenses increased from \$406,673 in 2021 to \$418,894 in season 2022. The major changes being Ball purchases \$160,284 (2021 \$142,488) & costs associated with the Seniors Presentation Nights (Men's & Women's) \$19,388 (2021 \$0). In addition to these costs, the RDCA appointed a Director of Junior Coaching at a cost of \$5,000 per season for the next 2 years. This position has been funded on a 50/50 basis between Cricket Victoria & the RDCA. We also committed to undertaking 2 Strategic Reviews during the season (these reviews are still continuing at the present time). The first of these reviews relates to the new Senior Women's Competition administration & the second is the continuation of the RDCA Overall Review which commenced 2 years ago. The cost of these reviews was \$10,000 & once again this is being funded on a 50/50 basis between a Sponsor & the RDCA. With the adoption of the State Governments COVID sign in protocols for Club venues & grounds last season the Association saved \$13,860 in COVID protocol costs.

After taking into account all of the above, the Association finished the season with a Surplus of \$18,801 compared to a loss of \$1,287 in the previous season. At seasons end we have cash reserves of \$130,196 including \$39,612 in the RDCA/YVCA transition account being used for ongoing support of the former YVCA Clubs under the terms of the Transition Agreement.

In closing I would like to thank all the Association's sponsors for their continuing support and also thank all Club Treasurers for their co-operation during the season.

## VMCU - Pat Meehan

Pat Meehan continued to represent the RDCA as our delegate to this body.

The VMCU consists of a Board made up of the 8 Directors of each Metropolitan Region, together with delegates from every Metropolitan Cricket Association. Pat Meehan is both the Director – Outer East on the Board and the RDCA Delegate.

Over the past season the main cricket activities have related to the management and implementation of metropolitan cricket and the impacts of Covid-19 which delayed the commencement of the season to mid-November 2021. The latter meant that this season the representative matches associated with CV State – wide T20 competition and the VMCU U/21 Neil Wright Shield were not held; however, the VMCU Junior Carnival proceeded in January 2022.

This junior competition comprised of 106 teams, including 34 girls teams, with about 1,300 players from 12 Associations with the inclusion of the Mornington Peninsula CA but Melton Junior CA merged into the Western Region Junior CA.

The RDCA was strongly represented with 10 teams entered in all grades. Success came with premierships in the U/16 Mackay Shield and runner up in the U/14 Allen Shield with another two teams competing in the semi-finals – U/14 Nolan Shield and U/14 Savage Shield (girls). Huge thanks are extended to all players, coaches, managers, parents, and umpires for their significant contribution to this successful Carnival.

The most significant matters dealt with during the season were:

- Negotiations with CV staff for 2021/22 cricket season and assessment of options for a delayed start due to Covid-19. Most Associations, including the RDCA, commenced on Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> November 2021 and fixtured 14 No.one day matches with finals. Impacts of Covid during the season were minimal with the loss of only one round in early January for the RDCA. The VMCU Board also considered playing dates for season 2022/2023 with a view to commencing on the first Saturday in October with a normal playing season of two day and one day matches.
- Identification of Member Protection Policy issues, being experienced in the implementation by Associations and clubs, to be considered as part of the current CV review and update of the policy. Urgent resolution of these issues was requested with a view to creating a new readable document.
- Implementation of Australian Cricket's Child Safety Framework by all Associations and clubs to meet the Victorian Child Safe Standards, especially the appointment of Child Safety Officers at all clubs state-wide. Clubs need to formally minute the adoption of the "Safeguarding Children Policy" to CV before the commencement of season 2022/2023.
- Continuing negotiations with CA/CV on MyCricket issues being experienced by Associations and clubs, particularly with live scoring, team entries for matches and results administration. A replacement platform – PlayHQ – is being developed by CA

contractors with staged implementation and trials of modules. A briefing on progress and the coverage of the components was provided by the CV Manager and relevant staff to VMCU Board and Delegates in December 2021. Trials of completed modules via Webinars are being produced every 3-4 months to provide progress on updates and seeking feedback, etc. The introduction of this new platform for Metropolitan Associations has been deferred by CV until season 2023/2024

- Following a review of the U/21 Neil Wright Shield format, together with only a very small number of associations being interested in entering teams, the VMCU Board agreed to suspend this competition for a few seasons. Discussions are current with the VCCL on continuing the annual match with the VMCU.
- Regular updates by CV staff on organisational changes, cricket participation statistics, schools and cricket blast programs, available grants to clubs and associations, the interaction with Youth Premier League, Premier Cricket and the Junior Carnival, and CV Strategic Plans for the next season.
- Extensive discussions the loss of umpires in most associations due to Covid and player behavioural issues (loss of respect for umpires decisions), recruitment of new umpires and the need for CV to develop a marketing program for next season.

In addition, the VMCU is also the body which deals with both club and player appeals against penalties imposed by an Association, which if it meets the criteria, would be considered by its independent panel for final resolution.

## Outer East Metro - Pat Meehan

The Outer East Region covers the municipalities of Knox, Maroondah and Yarra Ranges and comprises of clubs in the Ringwood and District Cricket Association (VMCU Affiliate) and the Ferntree Gully Cricket Association (VCCL Affiliate). The former Yarra Valley Cricket Association clubs have now been fully integrated within the RDCA Senior and Junior grades following a smooth and successful transition. One small rural club, Hoddles Creek CC, received significant recognition by being named as the “Community Cricket Club of the Year” in Cricket Victoria’s Community Cricket Awards for season 2021/22 and were a finalist in Cricket Australia’s National Community Awards. Our congratulations are extended to all involved with this club. This season the RDCA had 38 clubs with 160 senior teams, 258 junior teams (male and female), 23 women’s teams and 35 veterans teams with 4,800 overall participants. Premier Cricket is represented in the region by Ringwood Cricket Club with the Victorian Sub-District Cricket Association represented by both Bayswater and Croydon Cricket Clubs.

C V staff operating in the region for the season were Clinton Kennon, Area Manager and Stephen Box, Cricket Manager- Outer East Metro. These people assisted all clubs and work closely with them and schools in the region to offer a program of clinics, competitions, and activities to increase the availability of cricket in various formats to both male and female participants.

Ringwood C.C. is our partner for the regional pathway program and assists in the management and coaching of the Outer East Eagles U/17 male (Dowling Shield) and U/18 female squads. The former team were the premiers again this season. The Annual RCC v

RDCA match was played at Jubilee Park, main oval, on Wednesday 9th February 2022, with the RCC winning by four runs.

The region was strongly represented in the VMCU Junior Carnival held in January 2022 as the RDCA entered 10 male and female teams in all grades and FTGDCA entered 7 teams (6 male and 1 female). RDCA were the premiers in the U/16 Mackay Shield and runners up in the U/14 Allen Shield with another 2 teams competing in the semi-finals in U/14 Nolan Shield and U/14 Savage Shield. The FTGDCA had no finalist teams this year but were competitive. Huge thanks are extended to all players, parents, players, managers, coaches, and umpires for their significant contribution to this successful Carnival.

Women's cricket continues to grow within the region both at Premier Cricket level with RCC and the Associations. The RDCA girls competition grew again this season with 40 teams in 5 grades compared to 3 grades and 29 teams in the previous season. The standard is also improving as evidenced with some Stage 3 girls players making their debuts in women's teams. The RDCA established the "RDCA Women's East" competition this season, after consultation with both Cricket Victoria and the Women's Community Cricket representatives, to provide a pathway for all junior girls in both the Outer and Inner East Regions. This resulted in 21 clubs entering 23 teams in 3 grades including- 9 teams from RDCA and 6 teams from FTGDCA. Many of these were new teams included women who have never played cricket before and Stage 3 girls. This was a highly successful initiative with many other clubs from both Associations indicating that they hope to enter teams in this competition next season.

Once again Covid-19 interrupted the season with a delayed start in Mid-November and the cancellation of the first round in the New Year due to the high number of cases affecting both senior and junior players. All matches, including finals, were one day matches. Thankfully, the season and all finals were successfully completed with minimal impact on team numbers. Let us hope that the 2022/2023 season can commence on the first Saturday in October 2022 with a return to our normal fixture of two day and one day matches being implemented.

# SENIOR COMMITTEE REPORTS

## Secretary - Stuart Minetti

For the second season in a row the Covid-19 pandemic had a major impact on our season. Most clubs would have started their pre-season training in early August 2021 all to be curtailed within days when Victoria was placed into its 6<sup>th</sup> lockdown and all bets were off for pre-season training and the start of our season. We eventually managed to start our season in a very similar way to 2020/21 and cobbled together another 14 week one-day only fixture starting in mid-November.

The Senior Committee remained stable during season 2021/22.

All committee meetings were conducted using the Zoom meeting including the pre-season meeting with all clubs attending. Fortunately, although the pandemic was far from over, things had returned to something akin to normal such that we conducted the pre-finals meeting in March, 2022 at the new Ringwood Cricket Club rooms.

All recommended rule changes were accepted by the required  $\frac{3}{4}$  majority of clubs and this included Duckworth-Lewis for Premier Division one-day games. Grading for our second full season with Yarra Valley clubs proved challenging and it included the changing of the bottom two grades of District Division (G & H) to introduce a split innings format similar to Modified Division. The major difference is that batters do not have to retire.

Two slightly unusual promotions were made in Premier Division based on the RDCA Board policy of promoting 1<sup>st</sup> XIs as high as they can play if possible. Both proved to be justified with Heathwood 1<sup>st</sup> XI being promoted to Pascoe and making the finals. Woori Yallock 1<sup>st</sup> XI were promoted to Newey and finished 5<sup>th</sup>.

Our season started on 13<sup>th</sup> November 2021 with 160 teams in 20 grades and the Yarra Valley teams requesting full integration into the various grades. The first round after the mid-season break proved problematic with the Omicron variant of Covid-19 running rampant through a number of clubs. The round was cancelled due to significant player unavailability and the need to revamp some of our rules to cater for Omicron.

The finals were played as one-day games again and although the weather tried to intervene again on semi-final weekend we managed to get through without too much controversy. Grand Finals on both weekends were played in good weather.

Thank you to all club secretaries for the huge team effort that helped to deliver 1,099 senior games of cricket with a minimum of fuss.

Some interesting statistics:

Individual players who played at least one game of Senior cricket – 2,847

Least number of players played in one grade – Trollope with 137

Most number of players played in one grade – D Grade with 275

Thanks to Ian Spencer and Pat Meehan for liaising and meeting with council officers as required during the season and to Ian Spencer for again very competently organising all scorebook and cricket ball supplies.

Ground shortages for Saturday cricket remain an issue in most council areas and all councils we work with managed to supply replacement grounds or extra grounds where required to avoid playing on Sundays. Cheong Park (South Croydon) was being resurfaced, so was unplayable for the entire season, replaced by Griff Hunt. Seville Reserve North (Seville) was out of action, replaced with Gruyere Reserve. Warrandyte and Wonga Park with high team numbers continued to stretch Manningham Council for extra grounds, but all were able to be accommodated.

We still managed to run our T20 competition until the mid-season break, with 4 round robin rounds squeezed in before Christmas but the final round robin match and finals were cancelled due to the Covid-19 Omicron crisis in January.

Kilsyth CC is to be congratulated for the excellent feat of getting all 7 of their senior teams into the finals. Five teams made it to their Grand Finals and three achieved premierships. Ainslie Park CC had all their 6 teams in finals with four making it to Grand Finals and 2 premierships. Kilsyth CC won the *Phil McCallum Senior Club Championship*. Congratulations to Mount Evelyn CC who won the *Bob Bissett Best Administered Club* award, and Heathwood 1<sup>st</sup> XI, the *Bob Ellis Spirit of Cricket* award.

Congratulations to all grade premiers – 13 different clubs out of 36 across 20 grades were premiership winners. Multiple winners were Kilsyth with 3, Ainslie Park, East Ringwood, Montrose, Mount Evelyn and North Ringwood all with 2 premierships each.

The former Yarra Valley Cricket Association teams have blended into our competition very smoothly. This has strengthened the competition but more importantly provided an opportunity for those clubs to grow. Our close working relationship with the BHRDCA ensures all our young players are being challenged every Saturday morning and playing games appropriate to their skill level.

The girls competition continues to grow we increased from 31 to 34 teams across 3 age groups and 5 divisions. It is fantastic to see girls now have a pathway into senior cricket via the senior girls competition. The stage 3 Mandy Dolman Shield saw an amazing Grand Final, with Templeton and Chirnside Park / Waranwood playing out a thrilling tie and sharing the premiership.

Overall there were 28 divisions of cricket playing for premierships and we had 18 different clubs win premierships. This is a fantastic result and shows how competitive our competition is. Norwood have worked incredibly hard over the last few seasons and they were very deserving winners of the Bill Stafford club championship trophy. Along with the club championship, they also collected 3 premierships. Congratulations to all the Vikings who helped their club win this award.

Bill Stafford is our secretary but he fulfills many other roles and is always available to assist our clubs. Bill does all our fixturing and ground allocations early in the season. We thank Luke Henderson from South Croydon, Sean Meehan from Templeton and Steve Toohey from Warranwood who all provide wisdom, patience and their own vast array of experience to help the committee and our clubs.

The continued support of our major sponsor, Saxon Sports is invaluable. The ongoing support from Paul Attfield and Scott Brasher is much appreciated. Having access to their great indoor facility and the coaching they provide is so important for our young players. We had 250 teams this summer – exactly the same as last season!!

## Junior Secretary - Bill Stafford

For the 3<sup>rd</sup> year running COVID 19 was to impact our cricket season. Metropolitan Melbourne was forced into another lock down delaying the start of the season until the weekend of 12<sup>th</sup> Nov. We decided to have a similar playing season as last year i.e., 14 home and away games, plus finals, all being one day games.

A new COVID variant, Omicron, created another wave of COVID cases, particularly after Christmas causing disruption to some games. Games that were impacted, clubs were given an option to try an reschedule games or have them abandoned. Also, during this period, the RDCA provided a lot of permits to over aged players so that games could proceed.

It was a very difficult year for clubs, as COVID was taking its toll on families who were reluctant to commit to another season to cricket. However due to all their hard yards, we were able to get 250 teams registered, the same as last year.

This season with the support of Cricket Victoria (including 50% of funding), we introduced a Coach the Coaches Program. Dale Ingleton was appointed Director of Coaching. 15 clubs joined the program by appointing a lead coach to attend 3 master classes run by Dale and CV. Also, during the season Dale visited a number of clubs to either run training sessions or observe and provide feedback. Overall, it was a great success, which we will continue next season.

Our junior girls had another great season with 5 grades. The competition was the most even it has ever been with the standard of cricket continuing to improve. Our Stage 3 grand final finished in an exciting tie.

We welcomed new girl teams from Knox Gardens, Eastfield, South Croydon, Monash-Glen Waverley, which we hope to continue to do over the next couple of years, with our goal of every RDCA club having a female team.

Our inaugural All Girls Blast competition was successful, a special thanks to Warranwood, Ainslie Park, Warrandyte and Wantirna South for their help in getting this program started and growing. We want to build on this, as we are already seeing girls ready to feed into Stage 1 teams next season.

Once again, we joined forces with Saxon Sports and with Mukti Australia (a Christian organisation for disadvantage woman and children) in sending cricket gear to Sri Lanka. Clubs and families supported us in dropping off second hand junior cricket equipment and clothing to Saxon Sports. Over 80kg of equipment was shipped over to Sri Lanka.

# Vale Frank Bibby

Frank Bibby has passed away at the age of 97.

Frank Bibby was born in Perth, Western Australia on 24/12/1924 and moved to Victoria in 1949. He joined the Air Force at Ballarat in 1943, married in 1950 and had 3 children, a daughter and two sons. Frank was an Accountant and ran his own business in Melbourne.

Frank has had a long and distinguished career in sports administration with honours bestowed upon him from several competitions. His history in local sporting competitions dates back to the 1950s when he was Secretary of the RDCA (1957 to 1961) and Secretary of the Croydon Ferntree Gully Football League (now the Eastern Football Netball League) from 1958 to 1966.

The 1960's lead to further service to the RDCA as a Vice President from 1961 to 1967, with Life Membership of the Association being awarded in 1967 in recognition of his dedicated service. In 1967 Frank moved to become Secretary of Ringwood Cricket Club (1967 to 1970) and then became President of that club for the period 1971 to 1975. During this time, Frank maintained his involvement in Australian Rules Football as Assistant Secretary of Fitzroy Football Club (1969 to 1971) and he was awarded Life Membership of the (now) Eastern Football Netball League in 1969. From 1976 to 1980 Frank served Fitzroy as President and had acted as Fitzroy's advocate to the Victorian Football League between 1974 and 1980. In 1979 he was awarded Life Membership of the club.

In 1980 Frank Bibby was awarded an M.B.E (Member of the British Empire) for his services to sport in Victoria. This service continued in 1981 as he was again Secretary of the then Eastern Football League and was a member of the VFL Player's Appeal Board.
