President's Report - Timothy Court



At the end of the 2007/2008 season the Junior Committee sat down and reviewed the season and from there we set about developing a strategy to improve, on firstly the running of the Junior Committee, increasing our level responsibility to provide clubs with information to aid them with the running of the Junior Clubs and finally improve communication between the Junior Committee and the Clubs, Team Managers and Coaches.

The first step to achieve our goals was the development of the Junior Coordinators Manual which is intended to provide new Junior Coordinators with a guide as to what is involved with the role and to provide existing Junior Coordinators with a point of reference for information that is required during the course of the

season. We also further developed one page help documents to assist with registrations, clearances and permits.

One of the bigger changes introduced was the Team Accreditations. This required all teams entered into the Junior Competition to have one person regularly involved with each team to attend the Team Managers Information Night and also for one person regularly involved to hold a current level 1 or 2 coaching accreditation or attend a level 0 course in that season. It was also a requirement that the details of each Team Manager were provided to the Junior Committee for the purposes of email and sending SMS's. Whilst our intended newsletter struggled to get off the ground, the ability to SMS Team Managers on hot and we weather days proved to be an enormous advantage and limited issues on these days. The Team Manager meetings proved to also be very successful with the amount of match day issues reducing enormously.

In order to ensure umpires and team managers were easily identifiable on match day we introduced vests to be worn by these people. Whilst some people struggled with the concept of wearing a vest, this also proved to be a successful strategy.

The Match Day Checklist was also introduced this season to meet the insurance requirements and also force Team Managers to be on the same page before a match commenced. With the reduction of match day issues we strongly believe that this was a contributing factor.

It is without a doubt the biggest success of the 2008/2009 season was the Non Competitive Carnival. This is an event that has struggled to get off the ground for the past two seasons, so to have hundreds of parents and players at Silcock Reserve on a Friday night in February was a massive achievement. Justin Hansen, John Springett and Ryan Wilmott were the workers and the brains behind the success of this event and deserve high praise for their efforts.

Rebecca Court (nee Sheen) joined the Junior Committee in the role of Assistant Secretary and it was not long before she had made her mark. With John Springett moving house during September Rebecca picked up the slack and filled the breach until he was fully back online. Rebecca was of great assistance to both John and myself throughout the course of the season and was always willing to assist where she could and always did a first class job.

John Springett once again filled the role of Junior Secretary for the seventh season and as always was a hard worker and anything that you asked of him was never a problem for him. The experience that John brings to the committee is invaluable and he is definitely a key ingredient to the success of the Junior Committee in recent years.

John Kilby continued in his role as VMCU Carnival Coordinator and always when above and beyond what was required to ensure all players participating in the carnival enjoyed a smooth two weeks.

Josh Brown, David Brush, Paul Cardwell, Ryan Wilmott, Glen Wilson and Tim Sweeney all continued their involvement with the Junior Committee and were all very active from representing the association on the VMCU Council to getting up at 6:00 am to inspect grounds on a Saturday morning.

In their ex-officio capacities, Tony Gawne continued to assist in his role as Tribunal Officer, Stuart Minetti once again prepared the fixture, Hayden Hill assisted with the Grading Committee, Kevin Dawson prepared Presentation Night and the Team Managers evenings, Justin Hansen was instrumental with the Non Comp Carnival and Josh Browne was our jack of all trades with a hand in everything and always a valuable resource to call upon.

I would like to thank all members of the Junior Committee for their efforts throughout the season. I believe that the 2008/2009 season was once again a very smooth season and this can only be the result of the hard work of all members of the Junior Committee.

I would like to especially thank my wife Rebecca who not only took on the role of Assistant Secretary, but also had to plan and organise a wedding the week after Cricket Season, for all her support and assistance during the past season.

Finally on behalf of Rebecca and myself and would like to thank all the Clubs for their generous Wedding Gift presented to us at Junior Presentation night. It was certainly not expected and definitely greatly appreciated by us both and has already been put to good use. Thank you both Josh Browne and John Springett for their organising of this.

Clive Fairbairn Shield

The 'Clive Fairbairn Shield' is an award that is presented to clubs for overall success. It takes into account the success of every team from a particular club.

The following are the rules which governs the determination of this award:

31(c) Clive Fairbairn Perpetual Club Championship

- i. Points are to be awarded to teams fielded in competitive grades by multiplying the corresponding number of points from the following table by the number of premierships points for each team as they appear on the premierships ladder at the end of the home and away games.
 - U18/1, U16/1, U14/1 & U12/1 - 10 points
 - U16/2, U14/2 & U12/2 - 7 points
 - U16/3, U14/3 & U12/3 - 6 points
 - U16/4, U14/4 & U12/4 - 5 points
 - U16/5, U14/5 & U12/5 - 3 points
- ii. The total number of points thus gained by all competitive teams fielded by the club for all the home and away games of the season shall then be divided by the number of competitive teams so fielded to calculate an average.
- iii. The Total Championship Points will then be determined by the first multiplying the average calculated in (ii) above by 0.1 (10%), then multiplying by the number of teams fielded and finally using the result to the average calculated in (ii) above.

This year's winner was **Wonga Park**.
