





F. (Frank) Clota - 1935/1936

Frank Clota was an orchardist and ran a lemon orchard in Heathmont

Frank was a Foundation Member of Heathmont Cricket Club in 1922 and was the first captain of the club. He was primarily a top order batsman and won the Association's B Grade All-Rounder trophy in 1928/29. He captained the club for over 10 years and played there for a lot longer and during that time he was a club delegate to the Association.

Frank served on the Association Executive for a number of years and was a Vice President between 1930/31 and 1933/34. He also served as a Patron of the Association for some years.

It is noted in the Association's records that Frank donated 2 batting trophies in the 1930/31 season and provided funds towards premiership pennants on other occasions.

Frank Clota was awarded Life Membership of the Association in 1935/36. Later in life, it is thought that Frank took up Bowls and moved to Orbost and then Hawthorn.
